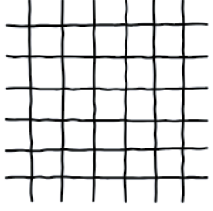


# I HAVE GOT

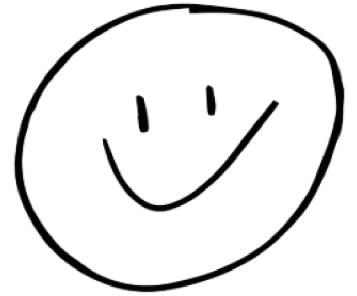

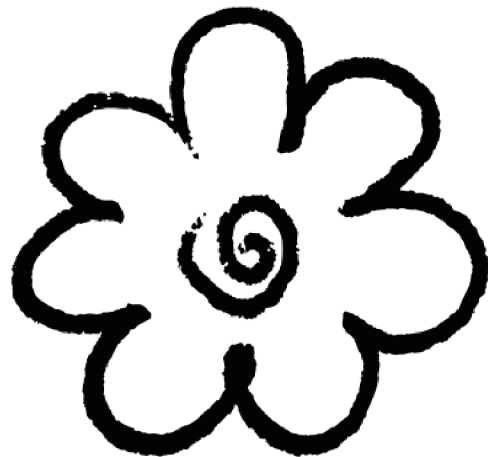
